DIRECTIONS:

From the West/East via Interstate 80: Follow I-80 to Exit 120 Clearfield/Shawville; exit right off the ramp, follow Rte. 879W toward Curwensville, about 4 miles to the intersection of Rte. 879 and Old Town Road (Kwik Fill gas station on right.) Go straight through the light onto Washington Ave. follow into Hyde, past Crown Crest Cemetery and Clearfield-Curwensville Country Club on the right. Entrance to Clearfield Area HS is ahead on Right

From the South/East via Rte. 322: Follow Rte. 322 to Clearfield, passing Lock Haven University Clearfield Campus and Clearfield Mall; take ramp on right after the mall for Rte. 879W to Curwensville. Follow directions above from Old Town Rd. intersection.

From the West: Follow Rte. 219N to Grampian to the intersection of Rte. 879E; go straight through the light and follow Rte. 879E to Curwensville. In Curwensville, continue to follow Rte. 879E toward Clearfield, traveling about 2.5 miles to "Y" intersection, get into left lane and bear a left under the RR overpass onto Washington Ave.; travel 1/4 mile to HS on the left.

HIGH POINT AWARD to solo twirler with most points earned. Division is determined by your solo classification. All solo events count 5 pts for entering each event, plus points for awards: 5pts. for 1st, 4 pts. for 2nd, 3 pts. for 3rd, 2 pts. for 4th and 1 pt. for 5th. (Special Beginner Solo and Special Beginner Basic not included.). 40 pts. minimum; forms available at registration desk.

Solo Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

Level (Special Beginner) Solo – No more than 1 spin/2 elbows Time: 1 to 2 min.

Level 2 (Novice) Solo – No more than 2 spins/4 elbows Time: 1 ½ to 2 min.

Level 3 (Beginner) Solo – No more than 3 spins/6 elbows Time: 1 ½ - 2 min.

Level 4 (Intermediate) Solo – No more than 4 spins/8 elbows Time: 1 ½ to 2¼ min

Level 5 (Advanced) Solo - No restrictions - Time – 2 to 2 ½ min.

Boys Solo – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over Time 1 ½ to 2 ½ min.

College Solo – combination of one-baton and novelty; use standard march music – time limit 1 ½ to 2 ½; one baton minimum of 1 minute

Beg., Int. & Adv. Instate Solo – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Time limit – same as solo classification; PA residents only

Beg., Int. & Adv. Visitors Solo – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Time limit is same as solo classification. Out of state residents only

Beg., Int., Adv. 2 Baton Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time Limit 1½ to 2 minutes)

Beg. & Adv. 3-Baton Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time limit ½ - 2 minutes)

Duet Twirl – Ages: 0-8.5, 9-11.5, 12-14.5, 15+ (averaged ages)

Rating Festival – performance for a rating only. Not a competition and all participants receive a ribbon. For special beginner (Level 1) twirlers only

Interview Clinic Lane – Interview practice for judge's comments; not a competition
