Camp Fee includes ALL instruction, as well as all meals, housing, camp t-shirt and camp photo.

Discount available for groups of 4 or more. Any teacher bringing 9 or more campers may attend camp FREE!

Discount for returning campers! Any individual who has attended TU camp(as a regular camper) in a previous year qualifies for the returning camper discount!

Schedule: Campers should plan to report on Sunday between 6:00 and 8:00pm. Camp closes at 4:00 on Wednesday. There is a performance for parents and the public at 3:00 on Wednesday which will last 45 minutes and is presented entirely from material taught at camp.

Housing: All campers are housed in a new, air-conditioned college dorm on a quiet campus! Rooms accommodate 2 people. Campers must bring their own bedding.

Health Information: Upon receipt of down payment, campers will receive a health certificate to be completed by the parent or family doctor. A physical is NOT required.

Day Campers: Twirlers may elect to attend camp only during the day. Day campers should plan to report by 8:15 and will be done at approximately 3:00. The day camp fee of \$45 includes lunch. (Registration paid the day of camp is \$55.)
