**From North or South** – take I-75 to (exit 102) 274E. Take 274 E through Jackson Center – continue 7 miles to school – located at cross roads 274 & 235 next to the high school.

**From East** – go to Columbus – take 33 NW through Bellefontaine- continue to 274W. (about 6 miles from Bellefontaine) follow 274 about 5 miles to school – located crossroads 274 & 235 next to the high school.

**From West** – go to Lima –follow I-75 south – (exit 102) 274 E through Jackson Center – continue 7 miles to school – located at crossroads 274 & 235 next to the high school.

*No personal chairs allowed in gym for anyone under the age of 60!

**AWARDS:**

A system of flexible awards will be used. For divisions with 3 or less contestants: 1<sup>st</sup> place trophy, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> place rosettes. 4-7 contestants: 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> trophies, 3<sup>rd</sup> rosettes. 8-10 contestants: 3 trophies. 11-14 contestants: 1-3 trophies, 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> rosettes. 15-20 contestants: 5 trophies. 21-25 contestants: 6 trophies. **HIGH POINT AWARD** to Beg. Int and Adv. solo twirler with most points earned. Division is determined by solo level. All individual events count 5 pts. for entering each event plus points for awards: 5pts. for 1<sup>st</sup>, 4 pts. for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3 pts. for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2 pts. for 4<sup>th</sup> and 1 pt for 5<sup>th</sup> (Level 1 (Sp. Beg.) Solo and Sp. Beg. Basic March not included). 40 points minimum. Forms available at registration desk.

**GROUPS:** Ages: Pee Wee (0-6.9); Tiny Tot (7.0-8.9); Juvenile (9.0-10.9); Junior (11.0-13.9); Senior (14 & Up)

All Team Divisions: Small (3-5 members); Medium (6-10); Large (11+ members)

**Dance Twirl Team-** Use own music. Time: 1 ½ - 3 minutes

**Twirl Teams** – march music. Time: 1 ½ - 3 minutes

**Duet Strut & Strut Teams** – Time Limit 1:00-2:30 Use Own Music

**Novelty Teams** – must use some prop or equipment instead of, or in addition to standard baton – Time: 1 ½- 3 minutes

**Poms**– Time: 1:30-3:00

**Majorette Squads (Jr Hi/Sr Hi/ College)** - Short Program: 2-4 minutes  
Long Program: 4-8 min.

**Color Guard** – Junior and Senior; Short Program/ Long Program

**Corps:** Floor, Street Parade and Mini – 10 twirling members minimum

**Production Groups:** 10 member minimum. Time: 5-9 minutes

**Beg. Best Appearing** (costume) – Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+(Time: 1:30 Max)

**Int. & Adv. Best Appearing** (costume) – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

**Nov. & Beg, Int, and Adv. Fancy Strut** – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over

(No specific pattern required –Time limit is 2 minutes maximum)

Solo Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

**Level 1 (Special Beginner) Solo** – No more than 1 spin/2 elbows Time: 1 to 2 min.

**Level 2 (Novice) Solo** – No more than 2 spins/4 elbows Time: 1 ½ - 2 min.

**Level 3 (Beginner) Solo**– No more than 3 spins/6 elbows Time: 1½ - 2 min.

**Level 4 (Intermediate) Solo** – No more than 4 spins/8 elbows Time: 1½ - 2¼ min.

**Level 5 (Advanced) Solo** - No restrictions - Time – 2 to 2 ½ min.

**Boys Solo** – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over Time 1 ½ to 2 ½ min.

**College Solo** – combination of one-baton and novelty; use standard march – music – time limit 1 ½ to 2 ½; one baton minimum of 1 minute

**Beg., Int. & Adv. Instate Solo** – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time: same as solo

**Beg., Int. & Adv. Visitors Solo** – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time: same as solo classification. Out of state residents only

**Beg. Int. & Adv. Two-Baton**– Ages: 0-8, 9-11,12-14, 15+ (Time: 1½ to 2 min.)

**Beg. & Adv. Three-Baton** Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time limit: ½ - 2 min.)

**Duet Twirl** – Avg. Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ March Music; Time: 1 ½ -2 ½ min.

**Solo Show Routine** – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over – Use own music – any type of dance with baton (novelties optional)– time limit 1½ to 3 minutes

**Duet Show Routine** –Same as Solo Show – Use averaged ages

**Basic Twirl Solo or Basic X Strut** – all contestants do the same prescribed routine

**Rating Festival** – performance for a rating only. Not a competition. All participants receive a ribbon. For special beginner twirlers (Level 1) only.

**Solo Pom** – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time Limit 1 ½ min. max – use own music)

**Duet Pom** - Same as solo pom – use averaged ages

**Color Guard Solo or Rifle/Sabre Solo** – Use own music, Time: Max. 3 minutes

**Interview Clinic Lane** – Interview practice for judge's comments; not a competition (May be done during Best Appearing or Group competition)
