From Buffalo (approx. 2 hours) :
 take N.Y.S. Thruway to Exit 42. Take Rte 14 South 1 mile
 Take Ramp onto Rte 96 South toward Waterloo
 Go 6 miles – turn R on Stark St. School is ½ mile on the left.
 From East: Take N.Y.S. Thruway to Exit 41 (Rte 414).
 Go 1 mile and turn R on Rte 318
 Go 1 mile and turn L on Burgess Rd
 Go 3 miles and turn R on North Rd. (Rte 106)
 Continue when Rte 106 joins Rte 96 – Go 1 mile to Stark St.
 Turn L on Stark St. School is ½ mile on the left
 From South: Take Rte 14 North then take US 20 East
 Turn L on Brewer Rd. and go 2 miles
 Turn R on Rte 96 and go 1 ½ miles
 Turn R on Stark St. School is ½ mile on the left.

HIGH POINT – to Beg. Int. & Adv. solo twirler with most points earned (division is determined by solo classification). All solo events count 5 pts. for entering each event, plus pts for awards: 5pts. for 1st, 4 pts. for 2nd, 3 pts. for 3rd, 2 pts. for 4th and 1 pt. for 5th.
(Sp. Beg. Solo and Sp. Beg. Basic not included.) 40 pts. minimum.

Majorette Squads (JrHi/ Sr Hi/College) - Short Program: Up to 4 minutes

Color Guard: Junior (0-12.9), Senior (13.0+); Short Program: Up to 4 minutes

INDIVIDUAL OPEN EVENTS

- Beg. Dress Model** – Ages 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time Limit 1:30 Max.
Int. & Adv. Dress Model – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time 1:30 Max.
Beg. Best Appearing (Costume Model) -Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over
Int. & Adv. Best Appearing (Costume Model) - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over
(with or without baton; 1½ minutes Max.)
- Nov., Beg. & Int. & Adv. Fancy Strut** - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over
(No specific pattern required -time limit is 2 minutes maximum)
- Special Beg. Basic March** -Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over
(Never won 1st place in Basic March).
- Beg. Basic March** - Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over
Adv. Basic March - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over
Beg. & Adv. Military March - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over

NOTE: TU rules limit the number of toss turns and rolls which may be executed by twirlers in the developmental levels of solo twirl. Check TU rules for specifics.

Solo Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

- Level 1 (Special Beginner) Solo** – No more than 1 spin/2 elbows Time: 1 to 2 min.
Level 2 (Novice) Solo – No more than 2 spins/4 elbows Time: 1 ½ to 2 min.
Level 3 (Beginner) Solo – No more than 3 spins/6 elbows Time: 1 ½ - 2 min.
Level 4 (Intermediate) Solo – No more than 4 spins/8 elbows Time: 1 ½ to 2¼ min
Level 5 (Advanced) Solo - No restrictions - Time – 2 to 2 ½ min.
Boys Solo – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over Time 1 ½ to 2 ½ min.
College Solo – combination of one-baton and novelty; use standard march music – time limit: 1 ½ to 2 ½; one baton minimum of 1 minute
Beg., Int. & Adv. Instate Solo – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over.
NY Residents only. Time limit – same as solo classification
Beg., Int. & Adv. Visitors Solo – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Time limit is same as solo classification. Out of state residents only

- Beg., Int. & Adv. 2-Baton** Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time limit 1½ - 2 minutes)
Beg. & Adv. Three-Baton Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time limit: ½ -2 minutes)
Duet Twirl – Avg. Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ March Music; Time: 1 ½ -2 ½ min.

- Solo Show Routine** – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over – Use own music – any type of dance with baton (novelties optional)– time limit 1½ to 3 minutes
Duet Show Routine –Same as Solo Show – Use averaged ages
Solo Pom – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time: 1 ½ min. max – use own music)
Duet Pom – Same as Solo Pom, Use averaged ages
Color Guard Solo or Rifle/Sabre Solo – Use own music, Time: Max. 3 minutes
- Rating Festival** - Performance for a rating only. Not a competition. All participants receive a ribbon. For Level 1 (special beginner) twirlers only.
Basic Twirl Solo - All contestants perform the same prescribed routine
Basic X Strut - All contestants perform the same prescribed strutting routine

Interview Clinic Lane – Interview practice for judge's comments; not a competition
(May be done during Modeling or Group competition- contestant's choice)
