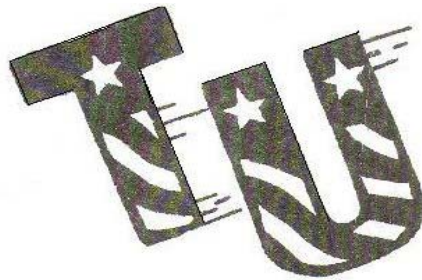

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Schedule: Campers should plan to report to Ramseyer Hall on Sunday between 6:00 and 8:00pm (Sunday dinner not included, so eat before you come). Camp closes at 4:00 on Wednesday. There is a performance for parents and friends at 3:00 on Wednesday. It will last 45 minutes and is presented entirely from material taught at camp.

Housing: All campers are housed in air-conditioned college dorm rooms which accommodate 2 people. Campers must bring their own bedding.

Health Information: Upon receipt of down payment, campers will receive a health certificate to be completed by the parent or family doctor. A physical is NOT required.

Day Campers: Students or teachers may elect to attend camp only during the day. Day campers should plan to report by 8:15 and will be done at approximately 3:00. The day camp fee of \$45 includes lunch. T-shirt not included, but may be purchased separately
