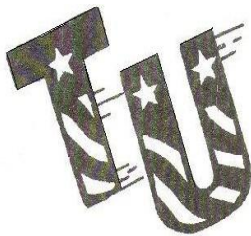

Camp Fee includes ALL instruction, as well as all meals, housing, camp t-shirt and camp photo.

Discount available for groups of 4 or more. Any teacher bringing 10 or more campers may attend camp FREE!

Discount for returning campers! Any individual who has attended TU camp in a previous year qualifies for the returning camper discount!

Schedule: Campers should plan to check in on Sunday after the competition or between 5:00 and 7:00pm. There is no dinner served on Sunday evening, so eat before you come. Camp closes at 4:00 on Wednesday. There is a performance for parents and the public at 3:00 on Wednesday which will last 45 minutes and is presented entirely from material taught at camp.

Housing: All campers are housed in college dorm rooms which accommodate 2 people. Campers bring their own bedding!

Health Information: Upon receipt of down payment, campers will receive a health certificate to be completed by the parent or family doctor. A physical is NOT required. A registered nurse is in residence.

Day Campers: Twirlers may elect to attend camp only during the day. Day campers should plan to report by 8:15 and will be done at approximately 3:00. The day camp fee of \$45 includes lunch. T-shirt not included, but may be purchased separately. Day Campers not pre-paid: \$55/day
